Documents

Smart Casual

Guest attire should be in keeping with what they would wear to a nice restaurant at home.

- Skirts/dresses, slacks, blouses, and sweaters for women
- · Pants and collared or dress shirts for men

Pool or beach attire, shorts, ball caps or jeans with fraying and/or holes are not welcomed in the dining room. Shoes must be worn.

Formal (2 Formal Nights on our 7 day cruise)

When formal nights are held, please observe the dress code in the dining venues for the enjoyment of all our guests.

- Evening gown, cocktail dress or elegant pant suit for women
- Tuxedo, dark suit or dinner jacket and slacks for men

Some Other Things of Interest

- Guests are permitted to bring one 750ml bottle of wine or champagne on board per voyage
- The ship has hot tubs and an indoor pool
- I have PDFs / Pics of my Travel Docs (license, passports, cruise paperwork, etc) on my phone. You can use Dropbox, Google Drive, Apple iCloud.

Cabin

- I like to give our room steward an extra tip when we first board. This usually helps ensuring we receive great service. Some ships will give you an option to do room service in the morning or afternoon. Some will also offer a Turn Down in the evening. I ask for room service in the morning and turn down.
- You can ask for an ice bucket and your room steward will take care of it.
- We like to have coffee delivered to our cabin in the morning. You can use your app for this or fill out the room service card and put on your door.
- The over door shoe organizer helps keep clutter down and makes it easier to organize your items. We have used one in the past, but not so much now.
- Magnets with hooks are great since the cabin walls and door are metal. Great for hanging up your medallion when you don't need it, hats, paperwork, etc.
- If you forgot something, you will be able to buy most items on the ship. It is better to bring it with you.
